LECTIO DIVINA WORKSHOP

Lectio Divina is one of the great treasures of the Christian Tradition of prayer. It means Divine Reading, which is reading the book we believe to be divinely inspired. The method of Lectio Divina is the most traditional way of cultivating friendship with Christ.

It is a way of listening to the texts of scripture as if we were in conversation with Christ and He was suggesting the topics of conversation. It is listening with the "ear" of the heart. The daily encounter with Christ and reflection on His Word leads beyond the mere acquaintanceship to an attitude of friendship, trust and love. Lectio Divina leads us to communion or as Gregory the Great (6th C.) summarizing the Christian contemplative tradition says "resting in God."
